

## REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL IOM Malaysia/ RFP No. 2021-001/MALAYSIA/ Provision of Feasibility Study – Alternative Dispute Resolution Mechanism CLOSING DATE: 30 APRIL 2021

The ADR Mechanism is a collaborative process to resolve worker grievances fairly, expediently, and confidentially through a facilitative and evaluative mediation process. Workers will benefit from better and quicker access to justice, and companies will benefit from a practical and efficient process to identify and mitigate risks early and meet the expectations of their international buyers who are increasingly subject to growing regulatory pressures. The mechanism is designed to complement existing judicial mechanisms and enable workers to achieve resolution in relation to their work environment in a fair, accessible, and transparent manner. ## **Objectives**

The overall objective of this consultancy is to conduct a feasibility study to understand: (i) the institutional environment in Malaysia to support an ADR Mechanism, and (ii) to assess the feasibility for a chosen third-party actor (i.e., an industry-based body, industry coalition, or similar business grouping with a corporate responsibility focus) (Industry Body) to administer an ADR Mechanism. The results of the feasibility studies will inform the potential pilots of an ADR Mechanism in the electronics and/ or palm oil sectors in Malaysia developed in partnership with the IOM and TRP.
