
TOTAL NUMBER OF IDPS CURRENTLY DISPLACED



NUMBER OF DISPLACED INDIVIDUALS IDENTIFIED BY EMERGENCY TRACKING SINCE 17 OCTOBER



As of 27 February:

- Nargizlia 1 camp reported an overall decrease of 8 IDP families;
- Haj Ali camp in Qayyarah sub-district reported an overall increase of 346 IDP families;
- Qayyarah Jad'ah 1 camp reported the decrease of 3 IDP families, Qayyarah Jad'ah 2 reported the decrease of 6 IDP families, while Qayyarah Jad'ah 3 reported a decrease of 17 IDP families;
- Qayyarah Jad'ah 4 camp started receiving new IDPs on Saturday night. The latest update is of the current registered population is 1489 IDP families:
- Qayyarah Airstrip emergency site reported an increase of 402 IDP families.

*Emergency tracking numbers are not cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family. The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
