
# 65 IOM Iraq Emergency Tracking: Mosul Operations DATA SNAPSHOT: 29 November 2016

Number of displaced individuals identified by Emergency Tracking since 17 October




#### Notes from November 28:

- Approximately 13 families displaced to Qaymawa (Zelikan ) camp moved to Dahuk governorate through sponsorship;
- 1 family from Merkaz Mosul sub-district arrived to Qaymawa (Zelikan ) camp;
- Approximately 61 families from Muhalabiya sub-district arrived to Qayarrah Jad'ah camp;
- Approximately 8 families from Talafar district arrived to Qayarrah Jada'h camp.

\*Emergency tracking numbers are **not** cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family.

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
