**PROPOSED ADJUSTMENT
TO THE IOM ASSESSMENT SCALE FOR 2009**

PROPOSED ADJUSTMENT TO THE IOM ASSESSMENT SCALE FOR 2009

1. By Resolution No. 1162 (XCIV) of 30 November 2007, the Council requested the Executive Committee, at its Hundred and Fifth Session in June 2008, to take such action as may be deemed necessary, as provided for in Article 12 (c) and (e) of the Constitution, concerning the 2009 scale of assessment.

Main principle and guideline

2. By Resolution No. 1159 (XCIV) of 30 November 2007, the Council authorized the Executive Committee, at its spring session in 2008, to adopt a scale of assessment for the year 2009, on the basis of an IOM assessment scale fully equated to that of the United Nations, as set forth in document SCPF/4, and updated with the addition of new Member States. Therefore, starting in 2009, the IOM assessment scale will be fully equated to the United Nations scale through the application of the equation factor¹.

3. By its resolution 61/237 of 22 December 2006, the United Nations General Assembly adopted the assessment scale for 2007, 2008 and 2009, reaffirming the fundamental principle that the scale is established on the capacity to pay.

Proposed IOM assessment scale for 2009

4. As decided by the Council:

- (a) the 2009 assessment scale is fully equated to the United Nations assessment scale;
- (b) the 2009 assessment scale has been updated with the addition of new Member States admitted in November 2007, the Republic of Burundi and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam.

Recommendations

5. It is proposed that:

- (a) the assessment scale for the Administrative Part of the Budget for 2009, as shown in the Annex , column 3 of this document, be adopted;
- (b) the governing bodies review the matter of the assessment scale for 2010 in the spring of 2009.

¹ The equation factor in IOM is used to equate the smaller IOM membership to the larger membership in the United Nations.
