## APPLICATION BY THE ISLAMIC EDUCATIONAL, SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATION (ISESCO) FOR REPRESENTATION BY AN OBSERVER

- 1. In a letter dated 4 November 2004, a copy of which is appended as Annex I, the Director General of the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ISESCO), made a formal application to be accorded observer status at meetings of the IOM Council. The Director General's reply thereto, dated 9 November 2004, is appended as Annex II. An appropriate item will be included on the provisional agenda of the Eighty-eighth Session of the Council.
- 2. This matter falls under rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure for the Council which provides that the Council may admit, upon their application, international organizations, governmental and non-governmental, concerned with migration, refugees or human resources as observers at its meetings.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council when this matter comes up for decision.
