

RETURN OF UNDOCUMENTED AFGHANS

WEEKLY SITUATION REPORT 13—19 OCTOBER 2019 Highlights 392,228 total returns from Iran and Pakistan

392,228 total returns from Iran and Pakistan since 01 Jan 2019

- 374,860 total returns from Iran
- 17,368 total returns from Pakistan

7,685 undocumented Afghans returned from Iran this week with **4%** of returnees from Iran (325 individuals) assisted

407 undocumented Afghans returned from Pakistan this week with **87%** of returnees from Pakistan (355 individuals) assisted.

IOM Thematic Support to Undocumented Returnees <u>Protection</u>:

81 case management assessments were completed in Bamyan, Kunduz, Kunar, Laghman, Kabul, Ghor, Takhar, Nangarhar, Herat, Balkh, Kandahar and Sar-e Pul provinces including 16 female headed household, 14 Unaccompanied Migrant Children, 7 medical cases, 6 elderly at risk, 4 physically disabled persons and 3 single females. In addition, 69 Unaccompanied Migrant Children, 24 medical cases, 7 Substance Abuse concerns cases, and 4 physically disabled persons received protection assistance in Ghor.

Migration Health:

A total of 1,596 undocumented Afghans were screened for tuberculosis. Of the total screened, 11 persons were found to be presumptive TB cases and referred for additional diagnostic/ treatment services. In addition, 93 patients received health services in the IOM Transit Centers.

Return from Iran

According to the Border Monitoring Team of the Directorate of Refugees and Repatriation (DoRR), a total of **7,685** undocumented Afghans spontaneously returned or were deported from Iran through the Milak (Nimroz) and Herat (Islam Qala) border crossings between 13—19 October 2019, with a 34% decrease from the previous week (**11,653**). **2,916** persons returned voluntarily and **4,769** were deported. This brings the total number of undocumented returnees from Iran to **374,860** in 2019. IOM provided post-arrival humanitarian assistance to **325** (**4%**) undocumented Afghans deported from Iran at its Transit Centers in Herat, including 38 Unaccompanied Migrant Children, 8 Medical Cases, 32 members of Single Parent Families, 3 Physically Disabled persons, 11 Unaccompanied Elderly persons, 1 Single Female, 137 members of deported families, and 8 persons with substance abuse concerns.

Situation Overview

As of 19 October, IOM's Cross Border Return Programme is 39% funded against its Humanitarian Response Plan request of 12.8M USD with 5.1M received from the Governments of Switzerland, Norway, Canada, the Czech Republic and CERF. Additional thematic funding has been received from ECHO for Protection programming and the Global Fund for Migration Health.

RETURN OF UNDOCUMENTED AFGHANS

Return from Pakistan

According to the Border Monitoring Team of the Directorate of Refugees and Repatriation (DoRR), a total of **398** undocumented Afghans spontaneously returned and 9 were deported from Pakistan through the Torkham and Spin Boldak border crossings between 13—19 October 2019. This number marks a 64% increase compared to the previous week (248). The total number of undocumented Afghan returnees from Pakistan in 2019 is now **17,368**. IOM provided post-arrival assistance to **355 (87%)** undocumented returnees from Pakistan over the past week.
