

RETURN OF UNDOCUMENTED AFGHANS

Return from Iran

According to the Border Monitoring Team of the Directorate of Refugees and Repatriation (DoRR), a total of **9,284** undocumented Afghans spontaneously returned or were deported from Iran through the Milak (Nimroz) and Herat (Islam Qala) border crossings between 09-15 June 2019, 124 % more than the previous week (4,137). **4,122** returned voluntarily, **5,162** were deported. This brings the total number of undocumented returnees from Iran since 01 January 2019 to **205,125**. IOM provided post-arrival humanitarian assistance to 618 (**7%**) undocumented Afghans deported from Iran at its Transit Centers in Nimroz and Herat, including 66 Unaccompanied Migrant Children, 17 Medical Cases, 70 members of Single Parent Families, 13 Physically Disabled persons, 17 Special Cases, 20 Unaccompanied Elderly, 4 Single Females and 220 members of deported families and 182 poor families.

Situation Overview

In 2019, IOM is projecting a return of over 570,000 returnees from Iran linked to ongoing economic challenges and a minimum of 50,000 returns from Pakistan, a figure that has already been endorsed by the Governments of Pakistan and Afghanistan. The remaining undocumented and Afghan Citizenship Card holding caseloads of more than 1,000,000 people may also face deportation from Pakistan in 2019.

Protection Assistance for Returnees

The Protection Unit completed case management assessments for 69 PSN cases in Kunduz, Sare Pul, Herat, Takhar, Balkh, Nimroz, Kabul and Nangarhar provinces, including 23 Unaccompanied Migrant Children, 19 Female-headed Households, 8 medical cases, 4 elderly at risk and 4 persons with substance abuse issues. In addition, 20 medical cases, 19 Unaccompanied Migrant Children, 13 Female-headed Households, 6 persons with disabilities, 3 single females and 2 victims of human rights violations received protection assistance in Kunduz province.

RETURN OF UNDOCUMENTED AFGHANS

Return from Pakistan

According to the Border Monitoring Team of the Directorate of Refugees and Repatriation (DoRR), a total of **321** undocumented Afghans spontaneously returned or were deported from Pakistan through the Turkham (Nangarhar) and Spin Boldak (Kandahar) border crossings from 09-15 June 2019. All of the returnees were spontaneous returnees. This number marks an **372% more** compared to the last weeks (68). The total number of undocumented Afghan returnees from Pakistan since 01 January 2019 is now 10,309. IOM provided post-arrival assistance to **97%** of undocumented Afghan returnees from Pakistan (312 individuals).
