

RETURN OF UNDOCUMENTED AFGHANS

WEEKLY SITUATION REPORT 20-26 OCTOBER 2019

Highlights

403,338 total returns from Iran and Pakistan since 01 Jan 2019

385,767 total returns from Iran

17,571 total returns from Pakistan

10,907 undocumented Afghans returned from Iran this week with 4% of returnees from Iran (436 individuals) assisted

203 undocumented Afghans returned from Pakistan this week with 99.5% of returnees from Pakistan (202 individuals) assisted.

Return from Iran

According to the Border Monitoring Team of the Directorate of Refugees and Repatriation (DoRR), a total of 10,907 undocumented Afghans spontaneously returned or were deported from Iran through the Milak (Nimroz) and Herat (Islam Qala) border crossings between 20-26 October 2019, a 42% increase from the previous week (7,685). 4,738 persons returned voluntarily and 6,169 were deported. This brings the total number of undocumented returnees from Iran to 385,767 in 2019. IOM provided post-arrival humanitarian assistance to 436 (4%) undocumented Afghans deported from Iran at its Transit Centers in Herat, including 70 Unaccompanied Migrant Children, 56 Medical Cases, 55 members of Single Parent Families, 7 Physically Disabled persons, 15 Unaccompanied Elderly persons, 3 Single Females, 66 members of deported families, 144 member of poor families and 50 persons with substance abuse concerns.

IOM Thematic Support to Undocumented Returnees Protection:

102 case management assessments were completed in Takhar, Nangarhar, Kunduz, Kabul, Herat, Ghor, Balkh, Sare Pul and Faryab provinces including 25 Unaccompanied Migrant Children, 42 poor families, 14 female headed households, 11 deported families, 8 elderly at risk and 2 single females. In addition, 25 female headed households, 22 Unaccompanied Migrant Children, 13 members of poor families, 13 medical cases, 9 elderly at risk and 7 deported families received protection assistance in Faryab, Jawzjan and Kabul.

Migration Health:

A total of 1,812 undocumented Afghans were screened for tuberculosis. Of the total screened, 36 persons were found to be presumptive TB cases and referred for additional diagnostic/ treatment services. In addition, 77 patients received health services in the IOM Transit Centers.

Situation Overview

As of 26 October, IOM's Cross Border Return Programme is 39% funded against its Humanitarian Response Plan request of 12.8M USD with 5.1M received from the Governments of Switzerland, Norway, Canada, the Czech Republic and CERF. Additional thematic funding has been received from ECHO for Protection programming and the Global Fund for Migration Health.

Return from Pakistan

According to the Border Monitoring Team of the Directorate of Refugees and Repatriation (DoRR), a total of **202** undocumented Afghans spontaneously returned and 1 was deported from Pakistan through the Torkham and Spin Boldak border crossings between 20—26 October 2019. This number marks a 50% decrease compared to the previous week (407). The total number of undocumented Afghan returnees from Pakistan in 2019 is now **17,571**. IOM provided post-arrival assistance to **202** (99.5%) undocumented returnees from Pakistan over the past week.
