

RETURN OF UNDOCUMENTED AFGHANS

Return from Iran

A total of **9,956** undocumented Afghans spontaneously returned or were deported from Iran through the Milak (Nimroz) and Herat (Islam Qala) border crossings between 30 Dec 2018 - 05 Jan 2019, **4% less** than in the previous week (10,371). 5,721 returned between 01—05 Jan 2019. This brings the total number of undocumented returnees from Iran since 01 January 2018 to 778,846.

IOM assisted 553 (6%) of undocumented Afghans deported from Iran at its Transit Centers in Nimroz and Herat between 30 December 2018—05 January 2019, 226 of which were assisted between 01-05 January 2019.

Protection Assistance for Returnees

The protection unit assessed a total of 83 PSN cases in Herat, Faryab, Sare Pul, Takhar, Kunduz, and Kandahar provinces. Of the total assessed cases, 41 were unaccompanied migrant children (UMC), 11 female heads of households (FHH) and 31 medical cases (MC).

Furthermore, 138 cases were assisted (53 female heads of households, 69 unaccompanied migrant children, 14 medical cases and 2 single females in Faryab, Kandahar and Sare Pul provinces).

The assistance included food, non-food items and dignity kits.

Situation Overview

Since 01 January 2018, IOM is responding to the return of over 800,000 undocumented Afghans from Pakistan and Iran. Undocumented returns from Iran in particular are seeing a massive increase of more than 200,000 to over 460,000 total between January-July 2018 versus 187,000 during the same time period in 2017, largely driven by recent political and economic issues in Iran including massive currency devaluation. As Afghans primarily work in the informal economy in Iran the demand for this type of work is drastically reduced. Further as all Afghans typically send home their earnings in the form of monthly remittances, the Afghan economy itself, already evident in the drought affected provinces of Herat, Badghis and Ghor, is suffering direct and immediate effects.

Return from Pakistan

A total of **667** undocumented Afghans spontaneously returned or were deported from Pakistan through the Turkham (Nangarhar) and Spin Boldak (Kandahar) border crossings from 30 Dec 2018—05 Jan 2019, 425 of which returned between 01-05 January 2019, according to the Border Monitoring Team of the Directorate of Refugees and Repatriation (DoRR). Of the total returnees, 597 were spontaneous returnees and 70 were deported. This number marks an **54% increase** compared to the previous week (434).
