Established since 1951, IOM is the lead UN agency for the recently signed Global Compact on Migration (GCM). IOM works closely with various intergovernmental and non-governmental entities. The Republic of Kenya was the first African country to become an IOM Member State in 1985. IOM Kenya is a member of the United Nations Country Team (UNCT) and Humanitarian Country Team (HCT). IOM is a key partner of the Kenya National Coordination Mechanism on Migration (NCM) since 2016. IOM has an MOU with the National Counter Terrorism Centre (NCTC) under the Office of the President.
