



Ebola Crisis: IOM response June 2016

Guinea

3,814 Total EVD* Cases Reported

2,544 Deaths

30,841 IOM Direct Beneficiaries

FMP* / sensitized : **988,033** persons

IOM activities :

- I. Health Border Mobility Management (HBMM) including : (1) Public Health risk mapping, (2) health screening at PoE and checkpoints especially during Micro-Cerclage, (3) Community Event Based Surveillance (CEBS) in border areas, (4) support to the implementation of IHR (EVD cross-border group functioning support, training and simulation exercises);
- II. Prefectural Emergency Operation Centers: Rehabilitation and logistic support as well as Public Health Emergency Management trainings;
- III. Renovation of health centers, health posts and border posts;
- IV. Socio economic support (cash-transfers, construction of markets, agricultural equipment purchases, etc.) to survivors and their communities;

Liberia

IOM activities :

- I. Ebola Case Management (3 Ebola Treatment Units);
- II. HBMM including Community Event Based Surveillance (CEBS); Flow Monitoring Points; health screening and at land, sea and airport POEs and checkpoints; IHR capacity strengthening;
- III. Rapid Response Teams capacity building within the Epidemic Preparedness and Response (EPR) consortium;
- IV. Essential Services revitalization including renovation and WASH improvement of health facilities and schools;
- V. Social mobilization and community engagement;
- VI. Psycho-social support and survivors' follow-up;
- VII. Health Care Workers Safe & Quality Service (SQS) trainings;

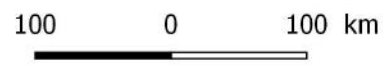
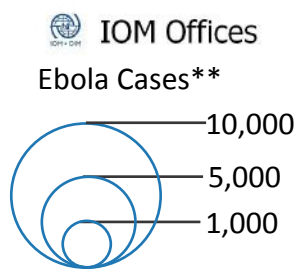
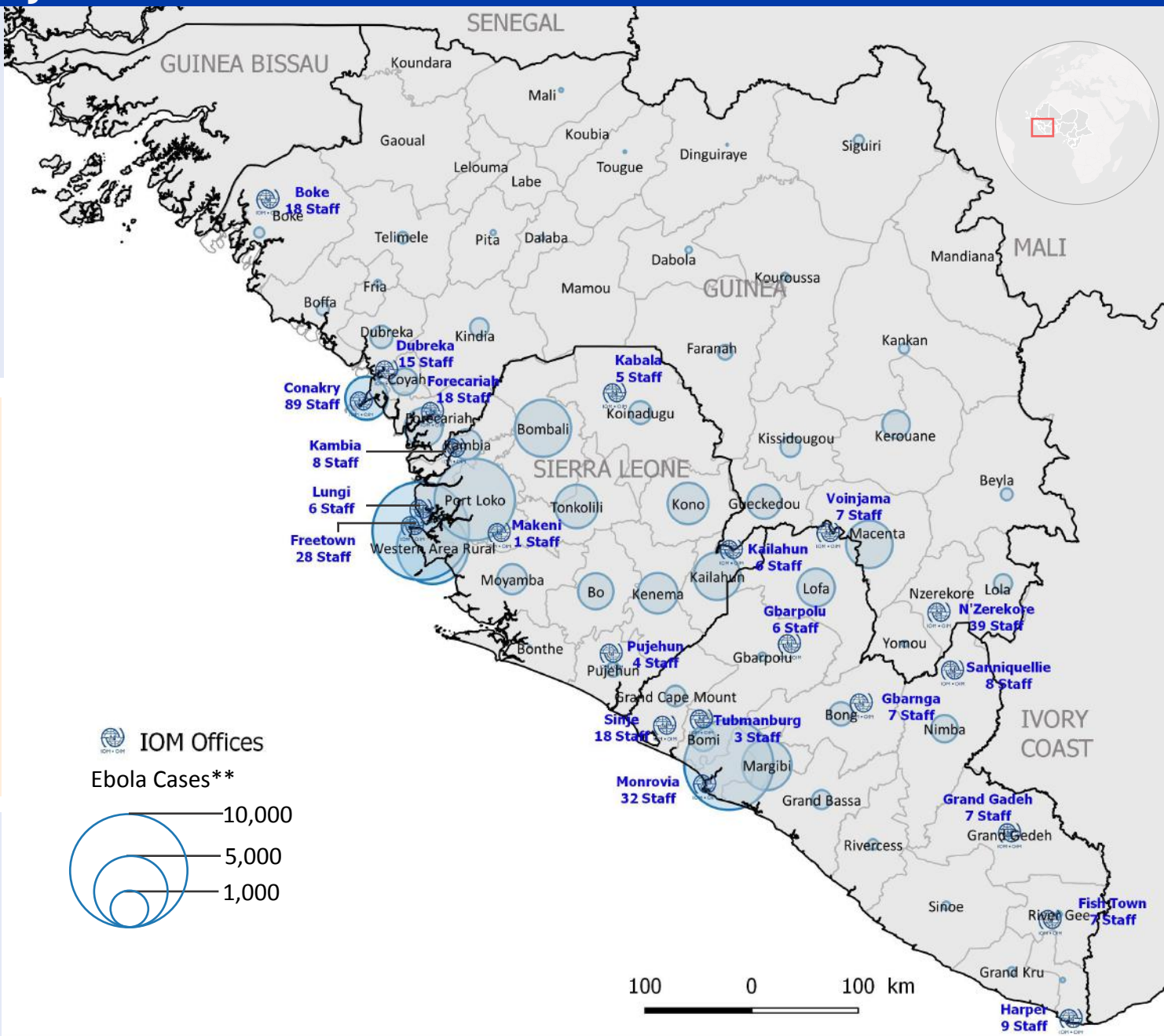

- IV. Health and Humanitarian Border Management (HBMM): Health screening, hand washing and population Flow Monitoring at Lungi Airport, sea and land crossing points and along main roads;
